Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order by Tom Carter at 5:00 pm.

Approval of Last Minutes:

The last minutes were voted to be approved moved by Steve Brown and seconded by Don Fisher.

Old Business:

Subcommittee Reports:

Research Subcommittee – Rick Bagwell:

RP-1033 Report from Tom Kuehn w/revised executive summary. Bill Welch gave a report on RP-1151, Phase 1. RAC broke it up into 2 phases. The research subcommittee has asked to keep the same contractor for Phase 2. The IAQ work statement may be beefed up some. Rick noted that TC 5.10 needs to slow down on what we submit to RAC given the current lack of research funding.

The research subcommittee recommended to endorse the 1033-RP final report; Rick moved to accept the report and Don seconded. The vote was unanimous with 9 votes and 3 members were absent. Tony Spata will be the conduit to recommend the 500 fpm duct velocity to the NFPA-96 committee. Don moves that TC 5.10 adopts the 500 fpm recommendation to NFPA, Mark Finck seconded. The vote was 9 for with 3 members absent. The subcommittee will write a letter for TC 5.10 members to sign and pass onto Tony Spata.

Handbook Subcommittee – Vern Smith:

We covered 8 pages out of 45 in Minneapolis and only got a ½ page ahead this meeting. The majority of time was spent on confirming and finalizing work on the ASHRAE terminology handbook. Note action plan now in place to be on target. Every week, Vern will send out about 4 pages for review and comments. When that is done, rev 3 will be sent out for review. The latest research will be incorporated into the handbook. The subcommittee may try some live editing on the web to see if this process can be sped up. The deadline for TC 5.10 to approve the new Chapter next Feb 2002 and then submitted to ASHRAE in May 2002. ASHRAE will make the SI edition if we do the IP edition. By October 2002, Galley Proofs will be delivered for review and the final version will be done in May 2003. Changes will be allowed in the CD-ROM version every year and updates in the paper edition will be made every 4 years. Future changes should include variable speed, grease emissions, and duct velocity findings. Vern is planning to finish all of the edits by the June meeting and new material will be done for the June meeting.
